We are writing to you regarding an education study that is to be undertaken by the African Population and Health Research Center (APHRC) in collaboration with the Ministry of Education and Sports (MoES), Kampala City Authority (KCCA), and in partnership with International Day of the African Youth/Child-Uganda (IDAY-Uganda). The study seeks to generate evidence on education experiences for learners in urban poor settlements. Two urban areas – Kampala and Mukono – have been selected to participate in this study.
