The instrument interrogates the circumstances surrounding their pregnancy, parental and community reactions, impacts of pregnancy on adolescent health and wellbeing, and future aspirations, including school re-entry and enrolment in apprenticeship. The first section includes questions on demographic and background characteristics, including their schooling and desire to return to school. The second section examines family characteristics.
